What impact has your work had over the past 12 months? How do you know? How has your subject developed?

Over the last year I have implemented and delivered a new Online Safety Program – This has been mostly successful, in that the children have had a solid understanding of keeping safe online.

I have also used my display areas in the ICT Suite to show progression from Y1 to Year 6, this is ongoing.

I have discussed with the children their expectations of Computing and how we could adapt to ensure new technology is researched and used within class lessons.

The ICT suite itself is being used more frequently – not just for computing lessons, and this is benefiting children across the curriculum.

Highlights of the Year.

Restarting the Digital Falcons for year 6. The year 5's will soon be applying to become a Digital Leader for the next academic year.

T4T in Online Safeguarding.

Working with EdTech at West Suffolk College to enhance the curriculum. Visits from one of their mentors working with 3 teachers across the school was a success.

How well do children achieve in your subject? How do you know?

Through using the age related expectations and assessing their work with this, I have seen that the children are progressing well. There are at least 5 children who are presently at or are about to achieve mastery level.

What steps are you taking to tackle underachievement and improve provision?

I have previously worked with EdTech, and will be contacting them for the new academic year for support to improve provision for low achieving children.
