Can accurately write some simple words and phrases using a model for support. Can make links between sounds and spellings. Can identify social conventions and festivals in other cultures.
4	Independently, the child Can listen for specific words & phrases. Can memorise & present a short spoken text. Can ask & answer questions on several topics. Can read some familiar words & phrases aloud with accurate pronunciation. Can read & understand a range of familiar written phrases. Can follow a short familiar text, listening & reading simultaneously. Can write simple words & phrases from memory. Can compare aspects of daily life in other cultures with my own.
5	Independently, the child Can listen attentively to understand more complex phrases & sentences. Can prepare & practise a simple conversation. Can understand & express opinions. Can read a variety of short texts. Can make & write simple sentences & short texts using a reference source. Can recognise similarities & differences between places. Can compare symbols, objects & products which represent your own culture with those of another.
6	Independently, the child Can understand the main points & opinions in a spoken text. Can perform a speech to an audience. Can use spoken language confidently to initiate & sustain conversations & tell stories. Can read & understand the main points & details from a short written text. Can identify different text types & read short, authentic texts for purpose. Can understand longer, more complex sentences. Can write sentences on a range of topics using a model for support. Can recognise some differences between people.
