Year 6 Tag Rugby



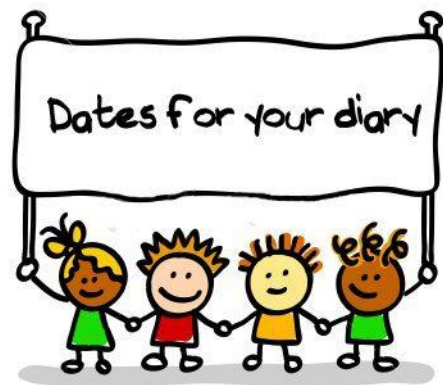
