



## Statement of Intent

When children leave Worlingham CEVC Primary School they will:

- have an increased sense of 'religious literacy' which helps them to understand the nature of religion and belief in the world they live in
- have a deeper understanding of some of the ideas and principles of the World's major religions and non-religious beliefs
- be able to make links between world religions with a knowledge and understanding of similarities and differences between these beliefs

- be able to express their feelings and views (with reflection and questions) of spirituality through encountering inspirational experiences that encourage wonder
