## Literacy

Throughout this term, we will be continuing to recap the phase 2 sounds and we will also continue to learn the phase 3 sounds.

Please continue to support your child with their reading at home, focusing on recognising and reading the tricky words on sight to help develop their fluency.

We will also be continuing to work on our independent writing and encouraging the children to write the sounds that they can hear in words. Please support this at home by encouraging your child to write shopping lists, cards, notes to a friend, a diary of their day or writing about a picture or objects in their environment. Please ensure that all attempts of independent writing are praised!

## Mathematics

During this term your child will be looking at numbers 1-20, focusing on being able to recognise them on sight and make them using smaller numbers.

We will also be continuing to focus on the number bonds to 10 and will be thinking about which two numbers added together make 10.

We will also be continuing to look at addition and will also introduce subtraction and how to solve number sentences using objects. Finally, we will be looking at odd and even numbers.
