Topic: Maps of Europe / Properties and changes of materials

<p>English Flash writing / Poetry The children will use images as a stimulus to create a narrative piece of text. They will then also use the natural environment to compose a narrative piece of poetry based on using the epic poem 'Beowulf'.</p> 	<p>Maths Multiplication / Division / Fractions / Converting units. The children will consolidate their understanding of \div and \times. They will also explore fractions by finding equivalent fractions, simplifying fractions and then moving onto learning the calculation methods of $+$, $-$, \times and \div fractions. They will continue to improve their fluency in calculations through regular 'Times Tables Rockstars' sessions.</p>	<p>Science Properties and changes of materials. The children will continue to learn about properties and changes of materials including uses of everyday materials and irreversible changes.</p>	<p>RE Islam: What does the Qur'an reveal to Muslims about Allah and his guidance? Children will explore ideas about revelation in Muslim narratives and the Muslim community / living. They will also examine the similarities and differences between faiths.</p> <p>MFL Transport The children will follow the 'Rigolo' language scheme and will continue to develop their French language skills. They will begin to talk about forms of transport and be able to ask / understand basic directions.</p>
<p>History / Geography 'Where are the special places of Europe?' The children will gain a greater understanding in their locational knowledge by exploring various regions from Europe whilst also developing their map work skills.</p> 	<p>PSHE / RSHE / Art Children will continue to make detailed, analytical drawings of still life and look at images of landscapes focusing on perspective, foreground, midground and background to create depth. 'Celebrating Differences' We will be looking at and celebrating the differences and diversity that are evident and extend from the classroom to the wider world. Key vocabulary: individuality, diversity, equality, identity, courage.</p>	<p>Technology – Computing / DT The children will continue to explore 'Scratch' programming. They will also make and improve a game using their logic skills and debugging errors. The children will explore Cam mechanisms and then based upon this will design, plan and evaluate a moving toy.</p>	<p>PE Gymnastics The children will use their knowledge of composition to use variation in level, direction and pathway. They will learn how to combine and link actions. They will use formations to improve the aesthetics of their performance.</p> <p>Music The children will continue to compose and perform their own music based upon the work by the Polish composer Grazyna Bacewicz.</p>
