



Spring- Term 2



This is an overview of your child's fourth term in Reception.

Literacy

Throughout this term, we will be continuing to recap all of the phase 2 and 3 sounds, as well as the tricky words that we have already learnt. We will also be practising to read longer words by chunking them up.

Please continue to support your child with their reading at home, ensuring that they are given multiple opportunities to read their books. Please also focus on reading the tricky words on sight to help develop their fluency.

We will also be focusing on writing and encouraging the children to write words, captions and sentences using their phonic knowledge.

Mathematics

During this term, your child will be continuing to look at the double facts up to 10.

We will also be thinking about how we can make 10, and will introduce the number bonds to 10 using two parts. These are two numbers added together that equal 10.

For example: $1+9=$, $2+8=$, $3+7=$, $4+6=$, $5+5=$, $6+4=$, $7+3=$, $8+2=$, $9+1=$, $10+0=$

We will also be looking at addition and will introduce number sentences and how to solve them using objects.

Topic

We hope you all had a great half term break! The children have all settled back into school well and have been keen to start learning about our new topic.

Our theme this term is: Wonderful World of Books

During this term we will explore: a range of different traditional tales, learning about what they are, and thinking about the different characters e.g. hero and villain. We will also explore storytelling and will have opportunities to act out different tales. We will learn about castles, thinking about the different features, as well as comparing the lives of people that once lived in a castle, compared to how we live now. In addition to this, we will learn about Spring, thinking about new life with animals and plants. We will also have opportunities to explore planting and growing.
