



Summer - Term 2



This is an overview of your child's sixth half term in Reception.

Literacy

Throughout this term, we will be continuing to recap all of the sounds that we have learnt. We will also continue to practise to read a range of different words.

Please continue to support your child with their reading at home, focusing on recognising and reading the tricky words on sight to help develop their fluency.

We will also be continuing to work on our independent writing, encouraging the children to write the sounds that they can hear in words. Please support this at home by giving your child different opportunities to practise their writing. Please also encourage your child to use finger spaces after each word and a full stop at the end of their sentence.

Mathematics

During this term, your child will be continuing to practise solving addition and subtraction number sentences. Please support this at home by writing your child some simple number sentences ($7+4=$ / $8-2=$) to solve using objects to help them.

We will also be continuing to look at sharing and how to share equally. You could support this at home by encouraging your child to share a set of objects between two or three teddy bears.

We will also be continuing to practise our doubling and halving, using objects to help us. Finally, we will also recap the number bonds that make 5, and odd and even numbers.

Topics

We hope you all had a great half term, and are looking forward to our last term in Reception.

The theme this term is: Our Wonderful World

As part of our learning this half term, we will be thinking about holidays and will also learn about some of the different continents, and the countries within them. We will travel to Australia, Africa, Asia and Europe, exploring the different countries, animals, food and ways of life.

We will also be thinking about our transition to Year 1, and will celebrate completing our Reception Year.
